

The linear feet of a tent's perimeter is the sum of the 4 sides of the tent. In this example - based on a 30 ' x 60' tent - there is 180 feet around it's perimeter

$$
\left(30^{\prime}+60^{\prime}+30^{\prime}+60^{\prime}=180^{\prime}\right)
$$

Sidewalls can be used for all or part of the tent's perimeter $1,2,3$, or all 4 sides - even partially along a side.
